


a Justice of the Peace in and for said County, Consider Warner
and Herman Harris and acknowledged that they have
caused a part of the land lying on section twenty (20)
in Township No. Six (6) North of Range Six (6) East to be
surveyed as a village of which this is a true plat, and that
they have caused all the streets and alleys therein marked
to be opened as public highways, and that they hereby make
the whole of said plat permanent by record.

PLAT -- VILLAGE OF FLUSHING

In application of James
Seymour for alteration of
Village plat.
vs
Mathew R Birdsall and Benjamin
F Warner.

It is ordered and adjudged that the prayer of the petitioners, be granted and that the street between Blocks 9,10,11, on the North and Blocks 12-13 and 14, on the South as laid down on the first map of the Village of Flushing, in said County, and recorded December 3, A.D.1840 in Volume, 3 of Deeds, be and the same is hereby vacated, and that it is further ordered and adjudged that Emily Street as laid down on the second recorded Plat of said Village of Flushing, between the above named Blocks as appears from said second map thereof, Recorded February 22nd, 1850 in Volume, 13 of Deeds on page 643 in the office of Register of Deeds in said County be and the same is hereby established and it is further ordered and adjudged that blocks 10 and 13, as laid down on the said first map of said Village be and the same are hereby altered to 20 rods, in width from East to West and that Oak Street, as laid down in said first map of said Village be and the same is hereby vacated and that Oak Street as laid down on said Second Map of said Village be and the same is hereby established and that said blocks 9-10-11-12-13 and 14, as laid down in said first map of said Village be and the same are hereby vacated and that Blocks 9,10,11,12,13 and 14, and the lots therein, be and the same are hereby established, as laid down on said Second Map of said Village of Flushing.


