Linden Residents/Business Owners:

We would like to pass along some information to our residents for the upcoming year. We hope this information is helpful to you.

- **Trash/ Recycling** – Trash pickup is every Friday morning unless there is a Holiday. Please have your trash/recycling out to the curb by 6:00 a.m. The trucks come very early in the morning. Enclosed is a 2018 recycling schedule. Recycling is every other week.
- **On the following Holiday weeks the trash/recycling will be picked up on Saturday.**

Memorial Day: Week of May 27, 2018 – Pick up will be on June 2, 2018

Independence Day: Week of July 1, 2018 – Pick up will be on July 7, 2018

Labor Day: Week of September 2, 2018 – Pick up will be on September 8, 2018

Thanksgiving: Week of November 18, 2018 – Pick up will be on November 24, 2018

Christmas: Week of December 23, 2018 – Pick up will be on December 29, 2018

- **Yard waste** pick up is ONLY from April 6, 2018 to November 30, 2018. This will be picked up with your garbage every Friday.
- **Snow Shoveling/Removal** – Winter is here! We want to remind residents/business owners that the property owner is responsible for keeping sidewalks cleared of snow during the winter months. Sidewalks must be cleared within 24 hours of snow or ice accumulation. If the City is forced to clear your sidewalks, expenses may be incurred. Also, when clearing snow, please refrain from pushing, shoveling, or blowing it into the roadway, as this inhibits snow removal and may cause road hazards
- **Garage/Yard sale permits** are available at City Hall for \$5.00. Only one permit per year per address. Permits are for a 2 week time period.
- **Burn permits** are for a calendar year (January 1st thru December 31st). The charge is \$10 for the permit. Before you can have a fire, the Fire Chief needs to come out and inspect the area. Please keep your fire pit at least 10 feet away from any structures or trees.

- **Water Bills** – We are continuing to do our water reads quarterly. The due dates for the water bills are as follows:

January 25, 2018

April 25, 2018

July 25, 2018

October 25, 2018

If for some reason you are unable to pay your water/sewer/recycling bill in full, please contact City Hall to discuss arrangements. If payment arrangements are not kept by the due date, your water/sewer/recycling will be turned off. We will no longer be rolling the water/sewer/recycling bills on to the property taxes. All payments **MUST** be paid at City Hall. Contact City Hall if you would like to receive your billing by email. We have a ACH program where we can debit your account to have your bill paid by due date. Please contact the city office for further information.

- **If you plan on selling your home**, please call our office to schedule a **MANDATORY** Home Inspection. We need at least a 7 day notice for the inspection. The home inspection fee is \$50.00.
- **Also when selling your home, a final water read is required.** Please call City Hall 2 days in advance to schedule the meter reading.
