When to Call for Inspections

Please call the building department telephone number listed on your building permit at least 24 hours prior to the time you need an inspection. A minimum of five (5) inspections are required on most structures. It is the permit holder's responsibility to call for inspections, prior to the construction being covered. When the inspection is done the inspector will leave at tag telling if it was approved or not approved.

Foundation Inspection

Prior to placing concrete in piers, trenches and formwork.

Backfill Inspection

Prior to backfill and after the footings, walls, waterproofing, and drain tile are installed.

Rough Inspection

The rough inspection is to be made after the roof, all framing, fire stopping, bracing, and the electrical rough, mechanical rough, and the plumbing rough installation have been approved and before the insulation is installed.

Insulation Inspection

The insulation inspection is conducted after all insulation has been installed and before any finish work is installed.

Final Inspection

The final inspection is to be made upon completion of the building or structure, and final electrical, mechanical, and plumbing before occupancy occurs.
