Do I Need A Building Permit?

A Building Permit Is REQUIRED For:

- All work involving structural changes (Roof wood or framing, enlarging windows, interior remodeling or floor plan changes)
- Demolition work
- Accessory structures larger than 200 square feet (shed, garages, etc.)

- Decks, 3 seasons rooms, gazebos
- Commercial Roofing
- All pools with a depth of 24" or greater
- Additions

Applications for a building permit are available online or at City Hall. The Zoning Ordinance is also available online. If you have any questions you can call (810)-735-7580

A Building Permit Is NOT REQUIRED For:

- Accessory structures less than 200 square feet. **NOTE:** A Zoning Permit is not required; However, compliance with the Zoning Ordinance is still required (see Shed Provisions Handout). Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical permits are required by the State if this type of work is being done.

Who Can Apply For A Building Permit?

- Builders licensed with the State of Michigan
- Property Owners can apply for work done on their own property

All Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical Permits are handled by the State of Michigan. Before work starts check to see if a permit is required. Contact the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) Permit Division at (517) 241-9313
